Research Assistant (PhD candidate)

The position is offered for a **period of three years**. The **starting date is as soon as possible**. The position is **part-time (50 % of regular working hours)** with salary and benefits commensurate with a public service position in the state Hesse, Germany (**TV-HE 13, 50 %**). The position is part of the interdisciplinary research project “Neurological Foundations of Economic/Financial Decisions”.

The job profile includes research in the field of Cognitive Neuroscience and Decision Theory. The research assistant will work on the neurological foundations of economic/financial decisions and use research methods like EEG/ERP, Eye Tracking, or measurement/evaluation of risk and ESG preferences. The job profile also involves publishing the results in international scientific journals and presenting them at international conferences. The position is limited to a time period deemed adequate for the completion of a doctoral degree. As part of the assigned duties, there will be ample opportunity to conduct the independent scientific research necessary for the completion of a doctorate. The limitation complies to § 2, 1 WissZeitVG.

We seek applicants with an academic university degree (diploma, master’s or comparable) in Psychology, Behavioral or Neuro Economics/Finance, Cognitive Neuroscience, or a related field. A solid grounding in Experimental Psychology, Cognitive Neuroscience, or Decision Theory as well as technical and methodological skills in EEG recordings or Eye Tracking is helpful. The willingness to acquire one’s own scientific qualification is expected.
